## **University of Houston School of Music**

The School of Music's reputation for academic excellence and the highest performance standards has attracted not only Texas students but many others from throughout the United States, Central and South America, Europe, and Asia. A vital resource in the educational and cultural life of Houston itself, the school, with its over 50-member faculty and 500 students, has one of the major programs in the state. Undergraduate and graduate degrees through the doctoral level are offered in theory, performance, composition, history, pedagogy, conducting, and music education.

Through the excellence of its curriculum, the distinction of its faculty, and through its alliances with the city's professional arts organizations—the Houston Symphony, Houston Youth Symphony & Ballet, the Houston Grand Opera, the Society for the Performing Arts—the school provides unique educational and performing opportunities which shall be further enhanced by the construction of a \$21-million state-of-the-art music building scheduled for completion in 1996.

The quality of the program is best demonstrated by the success of its graduates. In addition to the accomplishments of longtime alumni, an informal survey of recent graduates reveals that 63 now perform in professional orchestras, 70 in professional opera companies, 38 hold college and university positions, and hundreds teach at all levels in public schools and private studios.
